Thomas Paine, journalist and inventor was born in Thetford, in Norfolk, England on Jan. 29, 1737, the son of a Quaker. Short on education, he floundered through many jobs and was in and out of debtor's prison. He met Benjamin Franklin in 1774, in London. Franklin encouraged him to migrate to American providing him with letters of recommendation. He landed in Philadelphia in Nov. 1774. He used those letters to gain a position as co-editor of the Pennsylvania Magazine. It didn't take long to acquire the spirit of rebellion that was mounting in the colonies. Using his negative experience with the British government and the positive experience of the cause for freedom, he published a pamphlet and titled it "Common Sense" on Jan. 10, 1776. It became an instant hit and sparked fervor for the cause. It sold over half a million copies. He was on a roll and went on to write a number of articles title The American Crisis. The first one was published on Dec 23, 1776 and commenced with the statement, "These are the times that try men's souls". Washington was so impressed that he had it read to his men at Valley Forge. He served for a short time in the Continental Army but couldn't keep a secret. He designed a bridge but could get no backers. He almost lost his head in France and came back to die in N.Y City in 1809.
